The record would come attached to your transcript and would serve as an “official” way of having your community service activities certified. This is an excellent way to present all your community service and volunteering to any outside party. - In order to record your hours, you will be required to bring a provided log sheet to any community service events you participate in and have someone sign it for you. For Circle K events, you can get Anusha to sign the form.
